


As the new Social Media Coordinator I am looking forward to helping our club grow our social media presence.

In that time, incident reports have shown that running out of breathing gas is consistently among the most common incidents and is the Number 1 cause of dive fatalities. Unfortunate ly, even the most skilled divers have made mistakes and run out of gas.

In this presentation, we'll present the 13 most common factors that contribute to out-of-airemergencies and discuss how to mitigate them.

We'll cover problems related to situational awareness, procedural problems such as starting with a les-than-full tank and omitting predive checks, and common equipment issues.
