Getting too Little Cayman. The best way is to fly from the U.S. mainland to Grand Cayman (GCM). Then take the puddle jumper from Grand Cayman over to Little Cayman.

Travelers will need a current passport with a minimum of 6 months remaining on their passport.

Please be advised this is a very small island (10 Sq. Mi.) so there are <u>very</u> limited top side activities.
