BAKED MACARONI AND CHEESE WITH CRAWFISH

8oz pasta

ıqt water

160z crawfish tails (precooked and de-shelled)

4 slices of bacon

3 green onions

2 tbsp butter

1/2 cup Half and Half

1 diced jalapeño

1 tbsp creole seasoning (Tony's Creole)

2 tbsp flour

1 1/2 cup sharp cheddar cheese

1 1/2 cup Monterrey jack cheese

1/4 bread crumbs

Cook pasta in water with tsp salt until AL dente (per package instructions)

In a pan cook the bacon until crisp and remove - leaving grease in pan.

Crumble the bacon and set aside.

At medium heat melt half of the butter into the bacon grease melt butter and stir in green onions and jalapeño, cook for about 2 minutes.

Add flour and whisk to remove lumps. Cook for a minute.

Stir in the half and half, then add crawfish tails and cheese. Stir to remove lumps and heat the crawfish. About 2-3 minutes.

Fold in pasta and crumbled bacon.

Place in oven safe container and spread evenly.

Turn on broiler.

Melt remaining tbsp of butter and mix with breadcrumbs. Cover the mac and cheese and place in over under broiler until breadcrumbs are golden brown.

Virtual Seminar: Safety and Practical Issues for the Older Diver

Presented by Dan Orr with emcee Greg Holt from ScubaRadio.

"This presentation is a review of how the normal aging process affects diver safety, and what every diver should know about risk and risk mitigation to improve their safety, regardless of age.

When taking stock of our physical abilities and capabilities as we age there are absolutes that divers should be familiar with. The good news is that with age, usually comes wisdom and that improved judgment and reasoning can help you compensate for most negative body function changes. Knowing that we will have some level of impairment as we age brings us to how we can make accommodations and still dive safely. Aging is a fact of



life but how we handle growing older can make the difference between enjoying diving well into our Golden Years and having to prematurely hang up our fins."
